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
## A new chapter



## Personalised student support

### LEARN HAPPY

## Taking the plunge into higher education is a big step, no matter what age you are or where you're coming from.

That's why we've got loads of support in place to help you make the most of your time at university. If you have concerns about finances, mental health, travel, disabilities and inclusion, childcare, or living on campus and in the city, our staff and student colleagues can help.

We have a dedicated Disability & Inclusion Advice Service, which provides guidance and support relating to a wide range of disabilities, medical and mental health conditions, and Specific Learning Difficulties such as dyslexia and dyspraxia.

We also recognise that at times, life can be stressful. We have a Student Counselling service, located on campus, and the team are always happy to have a chat and arrange appointments for you.

Academic support is available through a range of services. You will have a Personal Development Tutor, who will provide you with academic support and guidance throughout your time at Marjon. There is also support available from our fantastic Library and Study Skills team. They run regular sessions on referencing, researching and resource literacy, and drop-in sessions if you're struggling with an assignment.

We also recommend you make the most of our library and computer rooms, open 24/7, and don't worry about library fines, as long as you return your books when asked.

If something has happened and you can't submit an assignment on time, you can apply for extenuating circumstances to give you some added flexibility from time to time.

If you have a concern about your physical or mental health, wellbeing, or have concerns for someone else, our Student Wellbeing and Support team, Student Life Officers, and Resident Student Assistants (for those living on campus) are around to help you.

Marjon is a small campus with a big personality, and with everything you need on your doorstep, you can't go wrong. With lectures a moment's walk from the Halls of Residence, there's no wonder campus is a desirable living location for our first years.

Our first-class facilities are bound to keep you busy. Get energised in our cutting-edge Sport & Health Centre, complete with a 25-metre swimming pool, gym, climbing wall, and Astroturf pitches. If you're injured, access our on-campus osteopathy or sports therapy clinics, to get yourself back to fitness quickly. Unwind in our cinema or games room, or get competitive on our Padel courts. Make time to discover your favourite books, or study in the library's dedicated workspaces and grab a coffee on the way in Barjon or the Grandstand Cafés. Visit Marjon Stores, our campus shop, to pick up your weekly groceries or grab takeaway food and drinks. You can drop by any time from 8 am to 10 pm, seven days a week, and with a wide selection of vegan and vegetarian options, there is something for everyone.

Marjon boasts a wide range of clubs, societies and teams that offer a great opportunity for socials and meeting new people, so whether your interest is sport, music, theatre or the great outdoors, you'll be sure to find your place.





## On-campus accommodation





Our accommodation is all on-site, meaning that everything you need is within a short walk.

My favourite thing about campus is the atmosphere. There's one great big family vibe, there's always someone around to talk to. You get to know people so quickly, just because you have something in common living on campus together, and I think that's fantastic.

This includes your lecture rooms and teaching facilities, the library, Barjon, our new community shop, the Sport & Health Centre, and much more.

It is also really affordable, with rooms starting at £113 per week. This is significantly lower than the average university-owned accommodation price in the South West of £166 per week (NUS/Unipol Accommodation Costs Survey 2021), leaving you with more money to spend on the things you enjoy.





Your rent includes bills and personal contents insurance, and as the accommodation is owned by the University, there are no hidden costs. Our accommodation and campus is secure, with 24/7 security and support from our Resident Student Ambassadors (RSAs).

We still have accommodation available for 2023 entry, and you can apply as soon as you're made

Our accommodation team do all they can to group you together with students with similar interests, or other Marjon students that you might already know. This way you can settle in quicker, building friendships and feeling part of the Marjon community.

### **Financial support** for students

The cost of living crisis can be worrying for many people, but you're in safe hands at Marjon. Our closeknit community is a great network of support, and we have an array of helpful options for those who may need it.



Marjon Provides – our community larder is there for anyone who needs it. We have meal bags ready for cooking, a wardrobe of clothes that you can borrow for an interview, a free table with items you may need for university life, and free tea and toast every morning.



Free sanitary products – toilets across the campus have free sanitary products that anyone can use.



**Budgeting support** – our Student Wellbeing and Support team has some great tools for learning how to budget and make your money go further whilst at university.



Placement travel funding – some trainee teachers might need to attend a placement that is a little further away. Our Student Funding team can support you with these extended travel costs.



**Bursaries** – we have a variety of bursaries available to students, including expenses for personal development, additional qualifications, care-experienced or estranged students, and accommodation a £1000 accommodation



Green travel discounts – you can get 20% off a Stagecoach 7-day ticket or a 28-day Plymouth City Bus ticket online.



Wellness pass – the Marjon Sports Federation offer a pass for just £20 per year (38p a week!), which enables you to use the sports facilities, bookable sessions, social events and activities at set times throughout the year.







## Jobs on campus

We know that earning whilst you study is important to many students. At Marjon, we have a range of Student Colleague roles available and a fantastic Futures team, who can help you find jobs in the local area and give great application and CV guidance.





Our Marjon Student Colleagues work across the University. They can be found greeting visitors as a Welcome Team Ambassador, improving the student experience as a Change Maker, supporting members of the public as a Recreation Assistant in the Sport & Health Centre, promoting Marjon as a Student Ambassador, assisting with Library and IT queries, and everywhere in between.

Our Student Colleagues love what they do because:

- they can work flexibly around their studies, picking their hours to suit them
- √ the majority of their work takes place on campus, so it's really easy to get to
- ✓ it helps them connect with other Marjon students and people from different courses
- they develop new employability skills, and receive ongoing training and support

  Ambassadors are paid £11.61 per hour
